GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Those eligible to enter in open class are Hamilton County residents, Hamilton County club members and their immediate family.

DROP OFF GUIDELINES FOR 2022

Exhibitors will drive to the Commercial Building. Here a volunteer will help to unload their exhibits. They will be provided with a ticket for exhibit pick-up on Sunday, July 31, 2022. Exhibits must be picked up Sunday from 3-5 p.m. Premiums will be picked up with exhibits, not mailed.

All projects must be dropped off Wednesday July 27, 2022 from 3-8 p.m.

Entry tags will be available from the Hamilton County Extension office and the Aurora News-Register prior to entry day or at the open class entry desk on fair entry day.

Special exhibiting requirements are listed in the opening paragraph of the respective classes and/or lots. Failure to follow proper preparation of exhibits will become a non-judged item. Exhibitor age divisions are listed with class descriptions.

No person is allowed to make more than one entry under each premium number, except for CLASS R (Home Brewed Beer and Wine).

4-H clubs, sororities and other organizations within the county will be awarded a \$15 premium if 80% or more of their members exhibit in open class. Entrants must list their organization affiliation on each entry tag.

Ribbons will be awarded by merit at the discretion of the judge. Ribbons denotation will include:

Purple – superior; Blue – excellent; Red – good; White – merit

Each class will have a "Best of Class" entry which receives a rosette ribbon. All unclaimed open class premiums will be returned to the society's general fund, fifteen days after the close of the fair.

Entries not meeting the class description will be reclassified at the discretion of the class superintendent.

CLASS A – SMALL ANIMALS

(ALL AGES)

ALL SMALL ANIMAL ENTRIES MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED to ensure pen/cage space. Entry forms are available at the Hamilton County Extension Office and may be returned there. Animals will be entered at the small animal barn located on the south edge of the fair grounds. Cages and/or pens will be provided, but exhibitors shall furnish their own food. Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning cages and/or pens daily, and be sure animals have adequate food and water for the duration of the fair. If anyone wishes to enter an animal for which there is no class, contact the open class chairperson prior for permission to make additional classes. No dog or cat classes will

be allowed. No person is allowed to make more than one entry under each premium number.

An antique quilt top is one where the top or blocks were begun prior to 1955 by someone other than the entrant and completed by the entrant within the last five years. A brief statement of 25 words or less explaining what was done by the entrant to complete the work must be attached to the exhibit.

The judges will select the “Best in County” quilt which may be entered in the Nebraska State Fair Best in County Quilt Show.

BEER
 RULES

1. All beers must be homemade by amateur home brewers, at their homes, not at commercial brew facilities. If made as a group/team, all brewers must be listed. Commercial beers and brewers may not enter.
2. Entries must be submitted in two (2) 12 to 17 oz bottles. Two bottles per entry are needed in all classes.
3. There is no limit to the number of entries per exhibitor.
4. No bottles will be accepted that have labels or other markings on them, other than official entry label. Entry labels should be applied to the upper 1/3 of the bottles. Please do not put labels over the top of the bottles.
5. Only the Superintendent, Judges, Helpers, and Scorekeepers will be allowed in the judging area.
6. Exhibitors and spectators are not allowed to converse with the judges during the competition. Violators will be disqualified or asked to leave the building.
7. Judges may enter the competition but will not be allowed to judge in a category in which they have entered.
8. Decisions of the judges are final.

9. All beer liquids will be disposed after judging is complete and bottles will be recycled after the Fair.
10. List the type of beer you are entering, i.e. Cherry Wheat, Dry Stout, Trappist Ale, etc. Do not list the name of beer i.e. Terminator Stout.

WINE
 RULES

1. All wines must be made by amateur wine maker, at their homes, not at commercial facilities. If made as a group/team, all brewers must be listed. Commercial wines and wine makers may not enter.
2. PLEASE NOTE. All wines require you to specify Sweet or Dry.
3. Entries must be submitted in a 23-27 fl. oz. wine bottle. Only one bottle per entry is needed in all classes, except where noted. Still wines should be in cork-finished bottles.
4. Entries shall bear no labels, markings, or bottle decorations, other than Official Entry Label. Entry labels should be applied to the upper 1/3 of the bottles. Please do not put labels over the top of the bottles.
5. There is no limit to the number of entries per exhibitor. All entries in the same class by an individual exhibitor must be different.
6. The judge's decision will be final.
7. The Grape Wine classes must contain only grapes. They may not be blended with any other fruit. At their discretion, the judges may disqualify any wine they feel violates this rule. Their decision is final.
8. Only the Superintendent, Judges, Helpers, and Scorekeeper will be allowed in the judging area. Exhibitors are not allowed to converse with judges during the competition. Violators will be disqualified and asked to leave the building. Judges will not be allowed to enter wines for competition in any class that they are judging.
9. All entries must list primary ingredient as noted below:
 Apple Zinfandel Elderberry, etc. Chenin Blanc Rhubarb
 It would be helpful to the judges to list any secondary ingredients also.
 All wine liquids will be disposed after judging is complete, and bottles will be recycled after the Fair
