



## Rules For Hamilton County Trailer Races 2023

### HAMILTON COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY

*(These rules are used in other Nebraska events)*

1. Any car, pick-up, station wagon, or suburban. No buses, motor homes, or farm trucks. This event is meant to be fun for all involved. Please do not compromise this aspect by over-building your entry. All entries will be inspected (for safety and items that may cause harm to other competitors) and those deemed unsafe will not be allowed see roll cage to participate. If you have any questions, please contact county fair officials
2. Helmets are **REQUIRED!!** Helmets must have full face shield or eye protection. Fire suit, gloves and neck brace are **STRONGLY** suggested.
3. Minimum of 3 point seat belt is required. 4 point is strongly recommended
4. All glass (except windshield) must be removed. Windshield may be removed but replaced with expanded metal. Window nets are allowed.
5. All lights, mirrors, and side trim must be removed from vehicle
6. All vehicles must have a Fire Extinguisher within arms reach of the driver
7. **ROLL CAGE.** Must be a rear hoop behind driver and passenger side (width of vehicle) Must have 2 kickers down from top of the hoop down to the frame. Must be a minimum 1 1/2" diameter pipe or tubing. No exhaust pipe for tubing. 4 or 3 point is recommended Drivers door may be reinforced on the inside (Highly recommended) Front bumper may be reinforced on the inside 3/8 plate or equivalent, Bumper must retain stock appearance, no sharp edges! Front grill may have expanded metal, six inch high hoop is allowed to protect radiator 3/16 tubing max. (six inches from top of bumper) skid plate under radiator is allowed.
8. All vehicles must have a clear number on both sides of vehicle at least 12" tall
9. **TRAILERS READ CAREFULLY!!** Trailers must be a trailer. Example pickup box, camper, boat trailer with boat, etc. Can not be tandem axle trailer, no semi-trailer. Trailer cannot be a piece of iron with an axle only. Official's have final say if your trailer passes. Any questions on what a trailer is ask fair officials. Must be of a ball hitch, no hitch pins, safety chains must be at least 3/8" chain. All trailers must be at least 6ft long from hitch to rear. **NO farm equipment! CAMPERS AND BOATS** must be cleaned out of all items. You are responsible for all camper parts and boat parts that fall off of your trailer! No boat no trailer!
10. Use of 4x4 vehicles is allowed but front driveshaft must be removed.
11. Tires and wheels. **MUST BE** standard DOT passenger tire no industrial or skid loader tires. Valve stem protectors are allowed. **NO** foam filled tires.
12. Battery must be relocated from under hood and placed in protective box and secured either inside or in the bed.
13. Skid plates are allowed
14. All doors must be either chained or welded shut
15. Minimum age is 16 years old with a valid drivers license, must have parent release form signed if under 18 years of age.

16. No leaving the track at anytime and no pit stops are allowed
17. No profanity, disrespectful flags or other sexual items allowed on cars – This is a FAMILY SHOW!!
18. **ALCOHOL IS FORBIDDEN BY ANY DRIVER!!!** Drivers or crew caught drinking before or during race will be disqualified!! ALL COOLERS WILL BE CHECKED!
19. **OBJECT OF THE RACE! PLEASE READ!!**  
This is not a race! The purpose of the race is destruction of other competitor's trailers. Last running vehicle with a trailer properly attached to tow vehicle and has axle in place on trailer will be the winner. You will be black flagged for hitting tow vehicle. Race officials may black flag you for not hitting any ones trailer. Again this is not a race it is a Night of Destruction! If trailer comes off ball officials have the right to flag you if they feel it is unsafe. If you lose the axle on your trailer you are out!
20. We will run heat races. There will be at least two feature races. There will be a intermission between feature races for repairs. Top 4 in consolation feature move to main feature. Main feature qualifiers will be determined by number of cars entered that night.
21. We may run an 18 year old and under heat if there is enough entered
22. We will not have a modified class
23. **ALL ENGINES MUST BE STOCK!** If it doesn't sound stock it's not stock!
24. All vehicles must pass inspection, Officials have final say on all rules.
25. If red flag comes out stop immediately. If you are pointed at by a official with a black flag you are out. Remember we are here for a show for the public not how fast you can drive.

**REMINDER THAT ALL CAMPERS/BOATS/ETC MUST BE CLEANED TO EXTERIOR ONLY!**

Please note...if you use a CAMPER as your trailer, you will be required to REMOVE ALL CONTENTS of the camper so that there are only the four exterior walls! While we love seeing the destruction of the campers, it takes too much time during the race for cleanup to pick up the kitchen sink, the refrigerator, kitchen knives, paper plates, all the clothes, etc. For time's sake and the safety of the drivers, they will be checked and this does include pop up campers!
